

MindStretch Travel Adventures, LLC – 2017 Programs
North Carolina Mountains / June 18-24 / 7 Days
Colorado Rockies / July 9-22 / 14 Days

There are two great trips planned for the summer of 2017. Trips are open to boys ages 9 and older. If your son wants to go and you're willing to send him ... then he's ready! Boys may, of course, attend both sessions.

Fee:

The fee for the **North Carolina Mountains trip is \$1,700**. The fee for the **Colorado Rockies adventure is \$3,100**. All trips include all lodging (motels/hotels with pools), all meals and some snacks, all activities, all admission fees, guide services, local transportation, and gratuities. The fees do not cover souvenirs and most snack food. Dinners are enjoyed in sit-down restaurants and boys can choose from the menu. Lodging is in motels/hotels (most or all with pools). Younger boys generally share a bed with another boy their age or about their age and older boys usually get individual beds though this isn't guaranteed. If your child prefers to have a single bed for every night, please contact Mark by November 1 for possible options.

The North Carolina Mountains trip will depart and return to Greenville and we can pick up and drop off boys in Asheville. **Airfare for the Colorado Rockies trip is not included in the trip fee**. We will plan to fly out of the Greenville-Spartanburg Airport, though Charlotte International is also a possibility. Dates, especially for the Colorado Rockies trip, could change by one day either way depending on availability of airline seats, etc. We would know this change several months in advance.

Some more you should know...

Deposits and Payments:

A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required to reserve your spot for each trip. Please make your check payable to MindStretch Travel Adventures. An additional payment will be requested in January and the balance will be due on April 12, 2017. Because of the limited number of participants, no refunds can be given for any reason after April 12, 2017.

Medical Emergencies:

If a participant becomes ill or injured, the leaders will do whatever is necessary to preserve the participant's health and safety including, without limitation, obtaining medical treatment at parents' expense. This could include transporting the participant back to his home for medical reasons. Parents agree to pay or reimburse any extra expenses incurred on the participant's behalf. Trip insurance is available from private companies that could cover special travel arrangements and medical care.

Please let us know if there are any medical conditions that would necessitate special consideration and care during the trip. A "permission to treat" form will be required as is a "release of liability." All forms will be sent to you in early spring.

Participants:

These trips are geared for boys who like a little (or a lot) of adventure in their lives. No two days are ever the same. These are not camping trips and they are not rugged wilderness experiences. Boys can expect to hike and walk a lot and do some camp kinds of activities. Mark Levin will lead both trips and will be assisted by other adult leaders. Parents are invited to inquire about joining us as a trip leader. Older boys often attend as trip assistants or junior counselors depending on age and past MTA experience.

Some Fine Print:

We cannot be responsible for events beyond our control, including, without limitation, acts of nature, war, strikes, or government restrictions. We are not responsible for loss or damage to luggage or any other personal belongings.

MindStretch Travel Adventures programs are "electronic free." Boys may use the director's cell if there's a real need to call home.

Students are expected to obey all regulations and rules and codes of conduct that might be set by the places we visit, the country's culture, or by the trip leaders. We have the right to send home with notice to parent or guardian, at parents' expense, and without escort, any participant who does not adhere to the rules and regulations, or who infringes upon others' enjoyment of the trip.
